New Interest Group Proposal Form

INTEREST GROUP – an MMSC-recognized, self-governing, student-run body of **academic** nature whose membership and events are open to all students.

An Interest Group is meant to engage students from all years in meaningful dialogue and action surrounding the objectives set out by the group. An Interest Group that is officially recognized by the MMSC is eligible to receive funding for its operations at the discretion of the MMSC following the submission of a budget.

The focus of the Interest Group **must** fall into one of the following categories:

- Medical discipline (Direct entry CaRMS specialties and internal medicine subspecialties/second iteration e.g. Cardiology, Radiology, etc)
- Social medicine (e.g. Environmental health, Refugee health, etc)
- Student life (e.g. Musical, Improv, etc)

Please note that all new Interest Groups will hold a probationary status for the first year of operations, and will require a debrief assessment with MMSC at the end of the academic year. Please check the MMSC website for more information regarding the submission of a non-Interest Group-related funding request. (Documents → Financial Forms → Special Funding Request Form)

BUDGETING CONSIDERATIONS:

- A maximum of \$50 will be allocated to each IG/Committee for food per standard event. Keep in mind: purchasing less expensive food options, such as fruit, vegetable trays, popcorn / light refreshments can stretch this funding to feed higher numbers of participants.
- Honorariums are a maximum of \$25 per speaker. This includes parking, other transportation costs, and any other expenses.
- Exceptions to these considerations may be handled on a case by case basis.

**Events with expenses less than \$150 do not have to be included in this budget (but can be if you want the funding approved sooner). These events can be allocated on a rolling basis via the Special Funding Form to allow for flexibility throughout the year as IG/Committee priorities change. To get reimbursement for a low-budget event (under \$150) after submission of your annual budget, please fill out the Special Funding form found on the MMSC Website (documents page). Please note:

- The Special Funding Form must be submitted at least 30 days before the event.
- A maximum of \$50 for food costs and maximum \$25 for an honorarium. If an exception is desired, detail this on the special funding form.
